

Ignore MAC Address on BioDigitalPC® 9 with CentOS 6.X

HOW TO: Ignore MAC Address on the BioDigitalPC 9 with CentOS 6.X

Login to your CentOS 6.X installation

At the command-line enter: **yum install biosdevname**

Note: This will probably do an update

Edit your **grub.conf** file with your favorite text editor: `nano /etc/grub.conf`

At the end of your kernel line add **biosdevname=1** at the end to activate the new package

Save and exit from **grub.conf**

Reboot

At this point you will have to re-do your network scripts file(s) located in **/etc/sysconfig/network-scripts**

From the command-line enter: **ifconfig -a** to find the ethernet's new name
